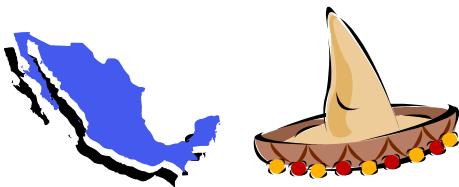

## MISSIONS UPDATE

**Mary Yuill is with CBI International**  
(www.cbi.org) and she reports that the  
Christian School In Senegal is functioning  
well with over 200 students in the pre-K  
and 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classes and that next fall  
they will add a 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Mary praises  
God for this miracle in a Muslim country.  
Mary says that the children learn English  
so she invites any teachers that would like  
to participate in a short term mission's  
project to contact them.

They also have a library that is used by  
about 300 Jr. and Sr. High students and  
teachers from all the surrounding schools.  
They have all the text books for all these  
other schools. Christian literature is  
always available and serves as great low  
profile form of evangelism to these  
students and teachers. This library will be  
moving across town which will cause  
these local contacts to be lost so they are  
in the process of raising funds for a new  
library.

Mary has made excellent progress in a  
Bible correspondence course on Angels,  
Demons and God's Justice that she is  
developing and she plans on using it in  
her own evangelism this summer in Thies,  
Senegal.

Mary reports that she is \$9,500 a year  
under supported, mostly because of the  
dollar falling in value. Mary recently had a  
computer crash and lost her email address

**Lucille Sanford is with New Tribes Missions** and she tells us that she has had a very busy January. Her department is responsible for preparations for a conference for their missions Representatives from all over the USA. Their mission is to take the Gospel to unreached tribes throughout the world. Lucille's job was the feeding of 50 - 60 men and their wives for the five day conference. In February they have a second conference for all the leaders from all the countries that they work in.

Lucille told us that she had an upcoming surgery scheduled for Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> to clear out an 89% plugged carotid artery in her neck. We trust that God has brought her through this surgery in good health but please pray for her recovery and protection from future problems.

Lucille closed her update to us with this verse:

Isaiah 26:3-4 "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee; because he trusteth in Thee. Trust ye in the Lord forever: for in the Lord JEHOVAH is everlasting strength!"

**The Jeffrey's are with Missions to the Americas** and Grey tells us that January marked Mary Ann's and his 31<sup>st</sup> anniversary from when they first departed from New York for Indonesia. Grey says that they are not close to retiring yet and

that they still have a number of years ahead to serve the Lord.

Grey reports that last year was the best financial year in 54 years for Missions to the Americas breaking eight million dollars in total income. This has created a general operating fund surplus allowing them to pay off another one hundred thousands dollars on their mortgage. In less than two years they have paid off half of their mortgage.

They are currently receiving ministry reports from their 154 missionary families about the spiritual impact they are making in North America, Central America, the Caribbean and Cambodia and they expect to have a family in Liberia next year.

Sound will soon be put in so that parents will be able to clearly hear the service. What a great addition to our church! Thanks trustees and others who made this possible.

Our 0-2 year old nursery has undergone a radical transformation in the last month. A new coat of paint, wainscoting, cubbies, coat hooks, and bookshelves are part of the completed renovations. The nursery shower scheduled for March 12<sup>th</sup> from 10 am to 12 pm in the 0-2 nursery will be a great time of celebration. We will shower the nursery with many needed toys for the children. All ladies are invited to come for this time of fellowship. Juice, coffee, and refreshments will be served. Please sign up on the bulletin board in the lobby. We deeply thank all those who gave generously of their time and resources to complete these renovations.

With the renovations come some changes in the drop off procedures for our children too. I share these with all of you so that you can all help to make our nursery a safe, happy, and nurturing place for the children of Calvary. You will quickly notice that the entrance to the nursery has changed. This is due to many reasons. The most prominent is that it provides a safer drop off location, away from the front door. It also reduces heavy traffic in and out of the nursery. Parents will now sign their children in on the sign in sheet, and put the diaper bag in their child's own cubby. They will take a nametag with their child's name on it to service with them and then return it to the nursery to facilitate pick up of their child. These changes should provide a safer, happier, and more nurturing environment for the children.

There is a great opportunity to join God in His work through the children's ministries of Calvary Baptist. We are still looking for three volunteers in the 8:30 and 11:00 services.
