Calvary Library Book Review – *The American Prophecies*

Michael D. Evans

Many have wondered if America has a place among the ancient prophecies of the bible. According to Mike Evans, noted Mid-East analyst and biblical scholar, not only is America affected by biblical prophecy, it is right in the “eye of the prophetic storm”. He clearly believes that there is a direct correlation between current events in America and biblical prophecy.

This book chronicles the Christian foundation of early America, how Christian Americans pleaded with presidents to support a Jewish homeland, and how America was instrumental in the rebirth of Israel in 1948 – the most significant prophetic event to happen in our generation- as well as the rise of terrorism in opposition to us. Interestingly, he shows how the scripture passages used at certain presidential inaugurations eerily became reflective of that presidency, as well as characterizing America’s role in bible prophecy at that time.

Evans effectively portrays how America is now “joined at the hip” with two ancient brothers, Isaac (patriarch of the Hebrews) and Ishmael (father of the Arab race). We are the only nation today with an alliance to both and it is getting us into trouble. Our government’s support of Israel has produced abundant blessing for our nation; however, it’s appeasement of terrorists, specifically by dividing God’s land, spells disaster for us. Evans firmly believes God’s hedge of protection was lifted from us on September 11th. He fervently prays that our nation will stay on the course that our Christian forefathers began, holding to the bible as its guide, and fully supporting God’s people and His land (Israel). He believes America’s position in the last days will ultimately be determined by which side we finally choose to be on.

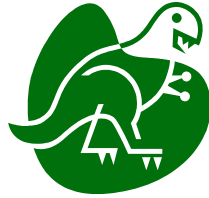

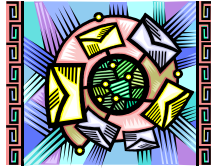
Claws and Jaws
